

Jean Day Attire: May wear any color jeans, jeans must fit appropriately and must have a belt. Cannot wear jeans that are baggy, sagging, holes, rips, tears, frays, patches, jeggings, joggers or have graffiti.

UP school polo shirts, UP Friday shirts, UP club shirts and UP sports shirts (all preapproved/affiliated with UP logo) may be worn with Jean day attire.

Any color tennis shoes are allowed (no rips, holes or graffiti allowed).

THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR WE HAVE \$1 DONATION JEAN DAY FRIDAYS. IF YOU WISH TO PARTICIPATE YOU WILL DONATE \$1 AND FOLLOW THE ABOVE GUIDELINES. IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO PARTICIPATE YOU MAY WEAR YOUR REGULAR UNIVERSITY PREP UNIFORM.

THE PURPOSE OF THE \$1 DONATION IS TO RAISE MONEY FOR SCHOOL PROGRAMS (SPORTS, MUSIC, ASB, CLASS OF 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 ETC.)

Free Dress Day Attire: pajamas, sleeveless, see through, lace, open shoulder tops or midriff shirts **ARE NOT ALLOWED!** GARMENTS (JACKETS, SWEATER, ETC.) COVERING SLEEVELESS TOPS DOES NOT MAKE SLEEVELESS TOPS OKAY. SO NO SLEEVELESS TOPS, PERIOD. No sandals or opened toed shoes. No sweat pants, joggers, warm-ups, leggings and/or jeggings. No jeans with holes, rips, tears, frays, patches or graffiti. No clothing that contains word or images depicting weapons, obscenities, drugs, alcohol, inappropriate wording or death.

Jean Day and Free Dress Day will include **tennis shoes** of your choice (no holes or frays), NO sandals or opened toed shoes.

*Jackets, sweatshirts and sweaters are not a part of the free dress day or jean day attire, so you will be required to follow the UP dress code.

ANY VIOLATION, PARENTS/GUARDIAN WILL BE CONTACTED AND MUST BRING A CHANGE OF CLOTHES TO THEIR STUDENT.
