Applicants must meet minimum requirements to be accepted for entrance in the Lottery Pool
(please see attached criteria)

- Lottery pulled applicants for acceptance (2021–2022) will be notified by email or telephone
- Final acceptance for the 2021-2022 school year will be **contingent** upon final grades, discipline and attendance, in June. Parent will be responsible for providing final grades and attendance.
- Each applicant will be given an application number
- Each grade level will be separated for their own vacancy pool
- Principal designee will pull application numbers for each vacancy spot, per grade level, until all spots are filled
- Principal designee will continue to pull applicant numbers for wait list, for each grade level
- Wait list will be posted, by application number, on our website at up.vvuhsd.org
- Wait list will only be valid for that school year. All applicants not accepted must reapply for the next school year

ADMISSION PRIORITIES/SIBLINGS

1. Siblings of current UP students or of siblings who graduated 2019 or 2020 (siblings must share a common, qualified address, including step sibling). This does not include extended family unless guardianship papers have been processed through the court system and are submitted.
2. Children of Victor Valley Union High School District employees. (must show proof by birth certificate)

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

We appreciate your interest in enrolling your student at University Preparatory. University Preparatory is a public school of choice that requires all of its students to adhere to a strict uniform policy.

We are a uniform school and parents/guardian are responsible to provide their own uniform to be purchased at designated stores.

Be aware that uniforms may become costly.

Students are required to take performing arts. Instruments will not be provided.

We do not have student transportation.

In order to be accepted into our school, your student must meet the following guidelines:

- **Applicants for 7th grade** must have a **G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher (transcripts will be reviewed for acceptance/eligibility), and nearly met or above standards on the assessment test.** Final acceptance will be contingent on 3rd trimester or 2nd semester grades.
- **Applicants for 8th & 9th** must have a **G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher and transcripts will be reviewed for eligibility.** Final acceptance will be contingent on 2nd semester grades.
- **Applicants for 10th – 12th** must have a **G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher and transcripts will be reviewed for eligibility.** Final acceptance will be contingent on 2nd semester grades.
- Minimal or no discipline from previous school(s).
- **ABSOLUTELY NO SUSPENSIONS** (since Jan. 2020)
- 90% positive attendance

HOW TO CALCULATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GPA

EXAMPLE: $4+5+3+2+3 = 17$ divide by 5 = 3.4 multiply by .8 = 2.72 GPA

University Preparatory es una escuela pública de elección que requiere que todos sus estudiantes se adhieran a una estricta política de uniformes. - Disciplina mínima o nula de la escuela anterior

- 90% de asistencia positiva

District Transfers

This is permission from their assigned district to attend to ours (VVUHSD). If you do not have this permission, you will be denied entry to VVUHSD. If you live in Adelanto and you are going into high school, you will not need the transfer.

Perspective 7th graders will need to complete an assessment test with their current school, resulting in nearly met or above standards. If no test is offered through current school district University Preparatory will administer one to you.

All applications, including sibling and priority, must be turned in at UP office by have April 15th, 2:30pm. NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED THROUGH EMAIL OR FAX. *No applications will be accepted between April 16th and April 30th*. Any applications accepted May 3rd and thereafter will be put at the bottom of the wait list.
